

# GRAHAM GOOCH'S SECOND INNINGS

*Graham Gooch's Second Innings* is an expansion disk for use with *Graham Gooch World Class Cricket* - it cannot be used on its own. This instruction sheet describes the enhancements and new features, but should be read in conjunction with the manual for the main game.

First of all, however, we would like to thank the many users who wrote to us with suggestions for improvements and additions. Unfortunately we could not include everything, but we've certainly done our best! Many of the changes are too small to mention individually, but if you're a real *World Class Cricket* addict you'll spot them! Please do keep writing in because we hope one day to create a version for the Amiga 1200 and CD-32.

## **Changes to the Game**

Included on the *Second Innings* disk is a replacement for the main program from your original disk. To use this enhanced version boot up with the *Second Innings* disk in the drive, but insert the original *World Class Cricket* disk when asked.

The changes you will notice are:

- the computer batsmen provide tougher opposition.
- you can view the scorecard for any innings, not just the current innings.
- ten games can be saved on a single disk, and you can now save the game at the end of a match.
- you can view the scorecard during computer vs computer matches, or save the match (press space between overs); any saved game can be restored as a one-player, two-player, or computer vs computer match.
